Policy regarding Compliance with California Proposition 65

Pursuant to Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, Phoenix Contact is not required to label its products with the “clear and reasonable warning” required by California Proposition 65.

The warnings are required when there is exposure to the chemicals in consumer products, or through environmental exposure or occupational exposure.

Phoenix Contact’s products are contained within an enclosure and are installed by our customers’ professional employees who are required under the Occupational Safety and Health Administration to follow occupational exposure requirements. Therefore, it is the position of Phoenix Contact that no exposure risk is present.
