Subject: California Proposition 65

Sensata Technologies is committed to providing accurate data relative to the material content of its products. Sensata products currently contain certain materials that are listed by California Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 Codified in California Health and Safety Code at sections 25249.5 through 25249.12.), such as lead and nickel. As certain Sensata suppliers consider material content information to be proprietary, CAS numbers for supplied proprietary materials may not be available for release.

Sensata parts are designed to promote recyclability, which include being in compliance to the end-of-life vehicles (ELV) directive and the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) directive.

California law requires that appliances, and certain materials within appliances, be properly handled. If Sensata products are properly disposed of and recycled per these guidelines, there would be no "discharge or release [of] a chemical known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity into water or onto or into land where such chemical passes or probably will pass into any source of drinking water." The details of the Certified Appliance Recycler laws can be found in Health and Safety Code Section 25211.

When used as intended, there is no intentional release of any material from Sensata products. As such, there is no exposure of "any individual to a chemical known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity." Nevertheless, despite the absence of exposure risk to a Proposition 65 substance this letter may also serve as "clear and reasonable warning" as to the composition of Sensata's products.
